4. You are not to promote a theological idea that you personally believe in.
5. We reserve the right to gently correct you privately, after the meeting is over in event of any doctrinal error.
6. We reserve the right to correct any misinformation presented by you after you have finished speaking to line up with the Word of God and our Ministry Mandate given to us by Holy Spirit.
7. Please be prepared for discussion, encouragement or even push back from the group, after you finish speaking.
8. Consider this experience as both an opportunity to share your story and a time for you to grow.
